The long-term impact?

The Energy Rescuers have left Clenchwarton Primary feeling excited and enthused about saving energy and the reasons behind it. The children loved the book and song and this has stayed in their minds. The visit from Rozzie Rat is something they won't forget.

Learning?

The children learnt about different ways that they can save energy – both at home and at school. They learnt the energy saving song and were given a book to reinforce the energy saving message.
