What did we do?

- Eco warriors continue to check each classroom at lunch and break ensuring lights etc are switched off.
- They now report back to their classes daily and explain why they got a green / red dot.
- We have a Eco page on our website and sent energy saving tips home to parents

The long-term impact?

- To reduce the amount of energy used and wasted.
- We are purchasing eco hand dryers to stop the waste of paper towels.

Learning and 'wow' moments?

- Snowy the Polar Bear has had a big impact and the Eco Warriors want to use him to remind everyone to save energy so we save his habitat. We are making polar bear reminders.
- The children loved learning that we should shower for 4 minutes.
